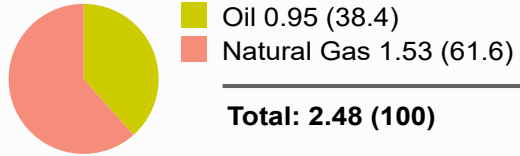

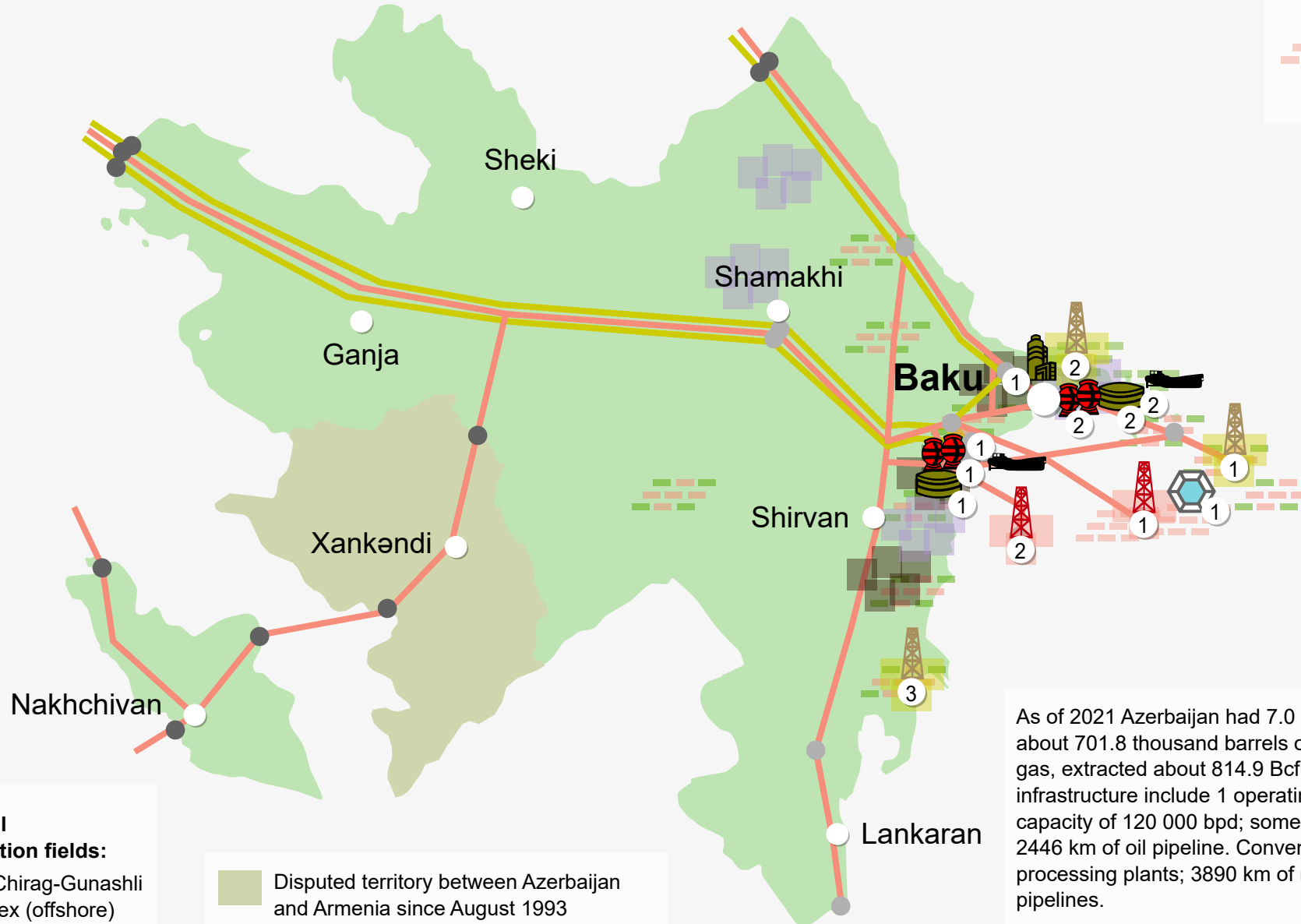

As of 2021 Azerbaijan had 7.0 bln barrels of proved oil reserves, extracted about 701.8 thousand barrels of crude oil per day, 60.0 Tcf of proved natural gas, extracted about 814.9 Bcf of natural gas. Azerbaijan's conventional oil infrastructure include 1 operating oil refinery with a total crude oil processing capacity of 120 000 bpd; some oil storages and oil terminals. There are 2446 km of oil pipeline. Conventional natural gas – include two gas processing plants; 3890 km of natural gas and 89 km of condensate pipelines.
