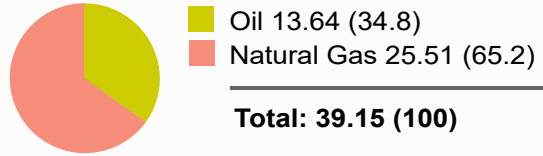

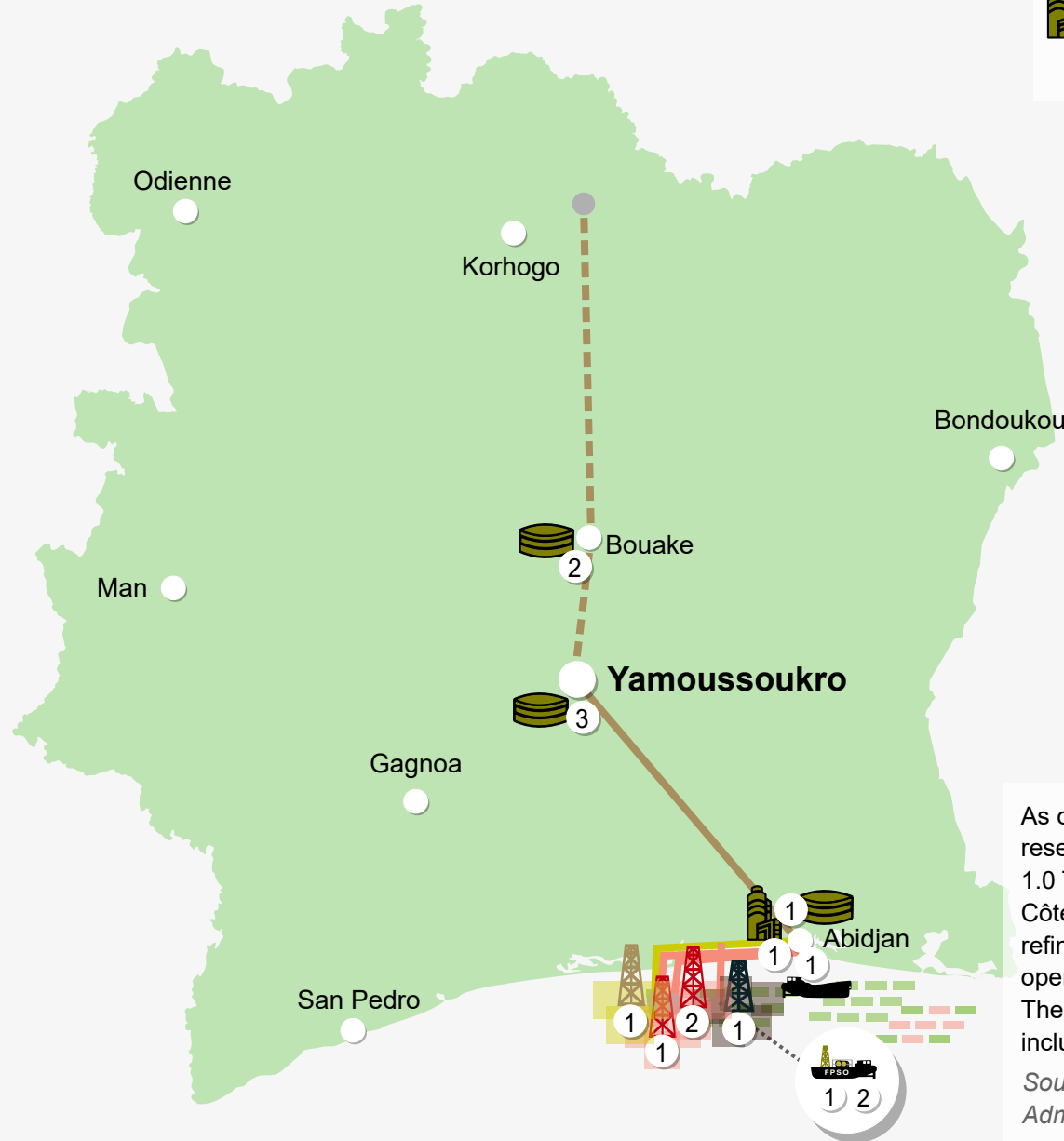

As of 2021 Côte d'Ivoire had 100.0 million barrels of proved oil reserves, extracted about 38.1 thousand barrels of crude oil per day, 1.0 Tcf of proved natural gas, extracted about 85.6 Bcf of natural gas. Côte d'Ivoire's conventional oil infrastructure includes 1 operating oil refinery with a total crude oil processing capacity of 71 000 bpd; two operating FPSO terminals, some oil terminals and oil storages. There are 118 km of crude oil pipeline. Conventional natural gas – include 256 km of natural gas and 101 km of condensate pipelines.
