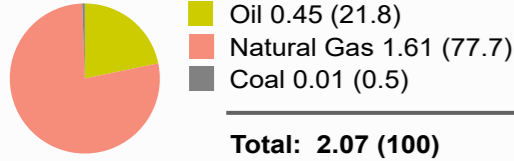

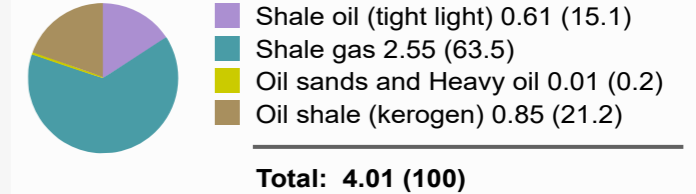

As of 2021 Egypt had 3.3 billion barrels of proved oil reserves, extracted about 602.7 thousand barrels of crude oil per day, 63.0 Tcf of proved natural gas, extracted about 2270.5 Bcf of natural gas and 16.0 million tonnes of coal, extraction permanently ceased since 2014. The Egypt's conventional oil infrastructure include 9 operating oil refineries with a total crude oil processing capacity of 721 500 bpd; some oil terminals. There are 5225 km of crude oil, 895 km of refined products and 957 km of liquid petroleum gas pipelines. Conventional natural gas - include 2 LNG export terminals with a combined capacity of 12.7 mln tons per year; 7986 km of natural gas, 486 km of condensate, 74 km of condensate gas pipelines; some natural gas processing plants.
