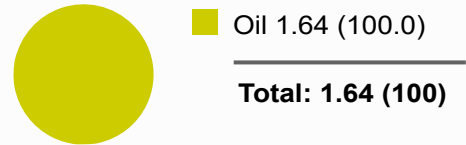

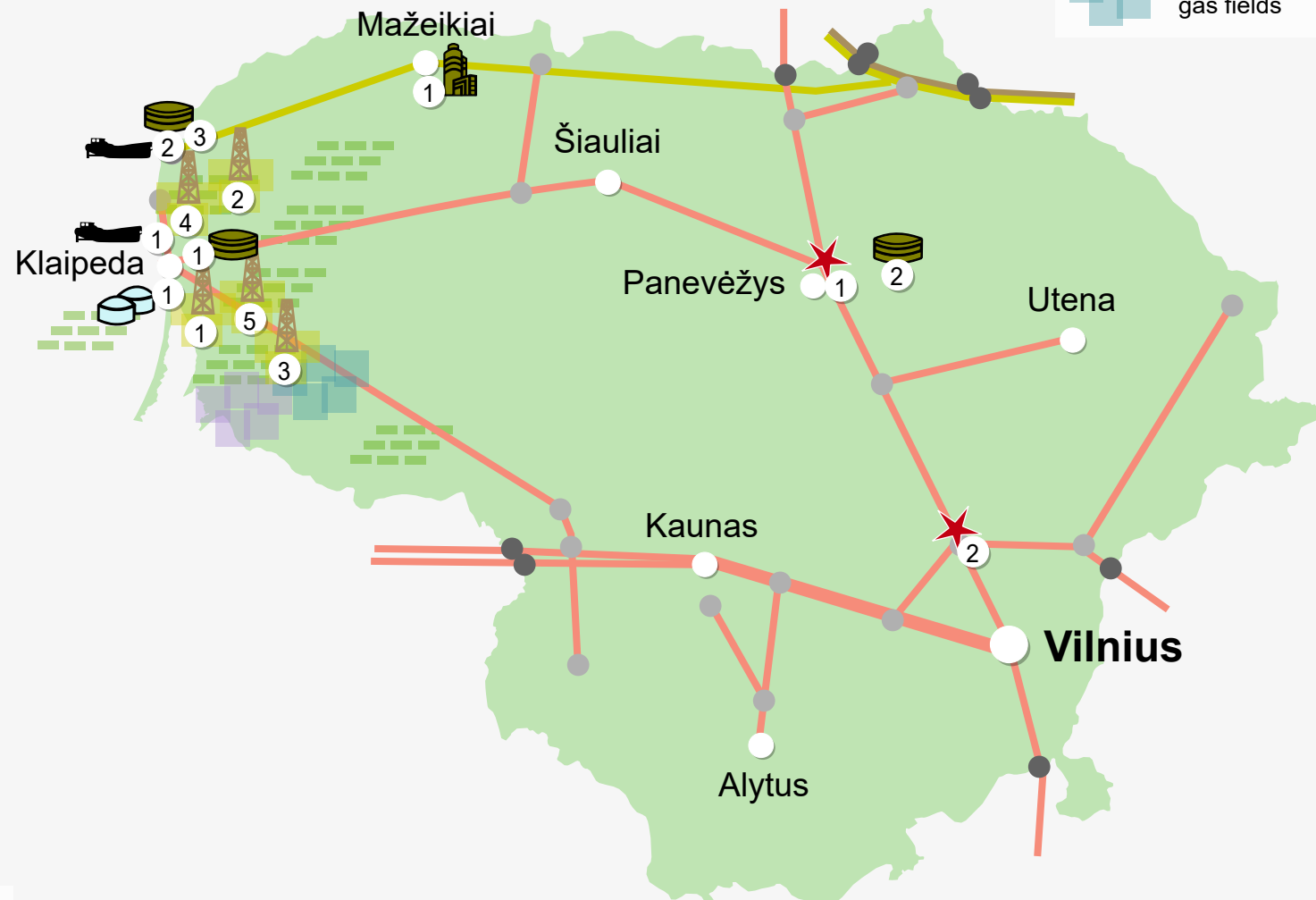
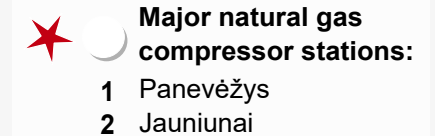

As of 2021 Lithuania had 12.0 mln barrels of proved oil reserves, extracted about 9.9 thousand barrels of crude oil per day. Lithuania's conventional oil infrastructure include 1 operating oil refinery with a total crude oil processing capacity of 263 000 bpd; some oil storages and oil terminals. There are 121 km of refined products pipeline. Conventional natural gas – include 1 operating LNG import terminal with a total import capacity of 3.0 million tonnes per year; 1921 km of natural gas pipeline.
