




As of 2021 Mexico had 5.8 billion barrels of proved oil reserves, extracted about 1.9 million barrels of crude oil per day, 6.4 Tcf of proved natural gas, extracted about 954.8 Bcf of natural gas and 1211.0 million tonnes of coal, extracted about 10.0 million short tons of coal. Mexico's conventional oil infrastructure include 6 operating oil refineries with a total crude oil processing capacity of 1.69 million b/d; some oil terminals and oil storages. There are 8775 km of crude oil, 7565 km of refined products and 2102 km of liquid petroleum gas pipelines. Conventional natural gas - include three operating LNG import terminals, 9 gas processing plants; 18 074 km of natural gas and 369 km of oil/gas/water pipelines.
