





thousand barrels of crude oil per day, more than 200 Tcf of proved natural gas, extracted about 801.4 Bcf of natural gas and 731.0 million tonnes of coal, extracted about 826.7 thousand short tons of coal. Venezuela's conventional oil infrastructure include 6 operating oil refineries with a total crude oil processing capacity of 1.27 million b/d; 4 operating extra-heavy oil upgrader plants with total capacity of 618 000 b/d; some oil terminals; 7588 km of crude oil, 1778 km of refined products and 981 km of extraheavy oil pipelines. Conventional natural gas - include more than 100 gas processing plants and 5941 km of natural gas pipeline, and some natural gas compressor plants.
